PANAMA WITH CANAL TRANSIT TOUR

Available as a private-guided tour throughout the year
Can be combined throughout the year with any tour in Costa Rica

Day 1: Upon arrival in Panama, you are transferred to an historic hotel in the former U.S. Canal Zone on the Pacific entrance of the Panama Canal.

Day 2: You begin your day touring the new museum and the 16th century ruins of Old Panama (Panama La Vieja). Afterwards, you visit Colonial Panama (Casco Viejo), stopping at the *Panama Canal Museum* and the San Jose Church to see its gold-altar. During the day you have an opportunity to purchase indigenous handicrafts of high quality. In the photo, one of our passengers is learning about molas (appliquéd textiles) made by the Kunas of the San Blas Islands. In the evening, you will enjoy a *typical Panamanian dinner and folk dance show*.

Day 3: Today is your transit through the Panama Canal. You can choose a full-transit, ocean-to-ocean of 8 hours, or a partial transit of 4 hours. You return to Panama City by motorcoach.
